## Scholarships made easy.

High school officials will report high school seniors to MTC for those who possibly qualify for Foundation, President's and College Tech Prep scholarships no later than May 1.

**Student's grades must be certified after the student's first semester, senior-year grades are posted.** The number of scholarships available will be limited and determined by available funds.

**Only one scholarship per student may be awarded.** Students will only be considered for scholarships after both this application and FAFSA results are received by Marion Technical College.

Each scholarship is for one year and will be credited to the student's account each term of the academic year. Scholarships will be applied toward tuition. Students must maintain satisfactory academic progress (SAP) as outlined in the MTC SAP Policy. Students may attend less than full-time and receive a pro-rated award.

## What scholarships are available?

The following scholarships are currently available to qualifying students:

### FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Available to high school seniors who are in the top five percent (5%) of their class. The Foundation Scholarship pays up to full time tuition charges.\*

### PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIPS

Available to high school seniors who are in the top 50 percent (50%) of their class. The President's Scholarship pays \$1,500 toward your first year tuition.

## Application Requirements

1. A 2.5 or higher GPA in high school.
2. Successful completion of proficiency exams.
3. Completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Results must be received by MTC by May 1.
4. Completion of this application, returned to your high school counselor. Application must be received by MTC by May 1.
